



acle...haha! I hope you all enjoyed journey-ing with me through the crazy process I get to endure every month!





Clint is an enthusiastic and passionate golfer. So it made total sense to join Serrano Country Club. Clint is eager to teach and share his love of golf







but he has learned how to manage his time. Playing baseball has taught Brent that failure can help you grow and that hard work pays off.



After a long flight through Amsterdam, we arrived at Kilimanjaro Airport and spent the night at Arusha Coffee Lounge where we received VIP service to freshen up before our bush flight to the Serengeti. I cannot describe the smell of the fresh air, the distances you can see, and beauty of Africa. It must be experienced! The Central Serengeti ecosystem is famous for its cat population and Moru Kopjes (granite outcrops) where the cats hang out

and give birth to their young.

Our first three nights were in Kiota bush camp in Ndutu Game Park. The Ndutu Plains lie between Ngorongoro Conservation area and the Serengetti, which allows off-road game drives. The splendid facilities have every modern and comfortable amenity you would find in a hotel, even though you are in a canvas tent in the wild, natural bush. The meals and beverages were superb. It generally rained a little each day, which was very appreciated by everyone, as it helped to keep the dust down while we were driving on safari. It refreshed everything, including the photographers!

Our days began waking up before sunrise to enjoy coffee and breakfast in camp. One day we had breakfast out in the field during a photo shoot. With only three to four people per vehicle (versus the normal 10-plus on most safaris), everyone, including the non-photographers on the trip, had a spectacular view of any action.

We encountered every animal possible, up close and ready for a photo shoot...elephants, giraffes, wildebeests, impalas, gazelles, waterbucks, topi, lions, cheetahs, leopards, dik dik, baboons, water buffalo, hippos, zebras and the very elusive caracal. We saw many species of birds and saw several species of eagles, hawks, and vultures. The birdlife and smaller animals were too many to mention.


After Kiota, we traveled to Chaka Camp, a sister camp of Kiota, located in the Southern Serengeti. We spent four nights there while a massive migration was taking place. March is the prime birthing season, so we were able to see many animals make their way into this world. Mother Nature is quite amazing to experience this up close and personal. Within a half hour, young zebra and wildebeests are able to stand, take their first steps, and then run with the herd if necessary. Over 500,000 wildebeests are born in March alone.

It rained heavily in Chaka Camp one night. The sound of thunder and lightning, along with the sound of the rain pounding on the tent, added to the exhilaration of being out in the wilderness with nothing but a sheet of canvas separating me from the elements. It





kept most of us awake all night. The heavy rain culminated into a mud-fest with a slippy-slide vehicle ride through the jungle the next morning. Think Mr. Toad's wild ride - wahoo!



If you haven't been to Africa on a safari, I suggest you put it on your bucket list. You will not be disappointed! I am returning July 24-August 7, 2020. So, if you have any interest, please let me know, and I will personally lead you on the excursion of a lifetime!


















# Almond Chicken APPETIZER




#### **Ingredients**

- 2 chicken breasts
- · 15-20 almonds
- 1 tablespoon of mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon cream cheese
- 1/5 teaspoon salt
- · 3-4 slices of toast
- 1 teaspoon olive oil



#### **Directions**

Leave the almonds in water overnight and peel the skin off. Cook the chicken breasts for 30-40 minutes in a pot with ¼ of a glass of water. Let the chicken breasts cool down for 15 minutes and then place them in a food processor. Add the salt, olive oil and the almonds to the chicken, and chop them using the food processor for 30 seconds. Add the chopped items to a clean bowl, add the cream cheese and the mayonnaise to the bowl, and stir them together. Toast the bread in a toaster to the desired crunchiness. Using a cookie cutter, cut the bread to the desired shape and size. Add the chicken on the toast and decorate.


It's January, so it's time to talk about new trends. The usual trends I see this time of year are: signing up for a gym membership (and not using it past March), starting the keto diet (or any diet) until mid-May-ish, and setting a goal to read six books a year (until you forget to finish that first one). This month, though, I'll share three tech trends I'm being asked about more and more, and that will likely sooner or later matter to those of us in Serrano.


Higher-resolution televisions - At the Consumer Electronics Show (CES) held each year in January, the newest TV ideas are showcased. One that I expect we'll see more of this year is the "8K" television. I saw my first 8K TV at CES in 2013, seven years ago. The 8K TVs will have four times the resolution of a 4K TV, and the ones that I saw had a picture so clear and vibrant that it looked as though I was seeing through a window rather than looking at a display on the wall. The image was so clear, it fooled my brain into thinking what I was seeing was actually **behind** the wall the TV was mounted on. Now don't plan on buying one of these this year, since there is no mainstream content available in 8K yet, but you can expect that movies will move to this format in the near future and that TV broadcasting, currently limited to HD (essentially "2K"), is gearing up to support 4K, and will likely go fairly quickly to 8K - in fact, the 2020 Tokyo Olympics will be a major showcase for 8K broadcast (at least in Japan), but how much of the Games will be broadcast in 8K in the United States or Europe is still unknown. The good news is that your 4K TV has several years of life before there will be a reason to replace it with an 8K model.

**5G cell phone technology** – You're likely hearing all the hype about 5G, and, if you have AT&T service, you may think you already have it, as some phones (including the latest Apple iPhones) will display "5Ge" for AT&T service. Sadly, this is not real 5G, but rather clever marketing of the most advanced 4G service. The good and bad news about 5G is that it's coming, and will likely be rolled out widely in 2020 by the major carriers, but that it won't make enough difference in performance for you to buy a phone just to get it. 5G is still only available in limited areas, and tests of the fastest speed technology have shown that it does not yet work well unless you're very close to the antenna, and you don't plan on moving (you'll lose the signal, and the 5G speed if you do). Before buying a 5G phone or 5G service, talk to friends that have it, and determine if the costs and actual performance are worth it to you.

Mesh network products provide better Internet access in your home. Many of us are using more and more Internet delivery of data to power our computers, phones, smart devices, and televisions, making the speed and reliability of that data more important than ever. You probably have an Internet router/Wi-Fi access point (or two) in your home, and experience dead spots and lousy speeds in certain parts of the house. In recent years companies have introduced a new kind of Wi-Fi system that addresses the larger and more complicated homes and applications popular in Serrano - called "mesh networks" - these devices have now grown up and can deliver the speed and reliability needed for today's applications. They consist of three or more small units that you place around the house to get far better coverage and speed from your Wi-Fi - and are easier to install and manage than ever. Look for names such as Netgear Orbi, Eero (my favorite - owned by Amazon), and Google Wi-Fi. These devices talk to each other to more simply blanket your home in reliable Wi-Fi and are easily extended by adding additional units to cover those hard-to-reach places - and don't require you to have a Ph.D. to install and use.

When we started raising our beef, we knew we had to do things differ-

ently. A lot of ranches raise grass fed beef for about 12-16 months before butchering. We wait until our steers are 2 years old before butchering. Waiting that long allows the animal to grow into maturity. This way there is more meat, with more fat and marbling, which means much better

flavor. The common misconception with grass-fed beef is that it doesn't taste as good because it is too lean. That is not the case with our grass-fed beef. We're breaking these perceptions with every new customer. We truly believe this is the best grass-fed beef you'll ever eat.

Also, as of December 2019, we've partnered up with our friends, Cosmic Root Ranch in Grass Valley, to start carrying pastured pork as well. These pigs are like nothing you've ever seen, or tasted. The breed is Mangalitsa. It's a heritage breed of pork from Hungary. It is truly the most amazing pork we have ever eaten and are so excited to offer it to you! It's known as the Kobi beef of pork, and within one bite, you'll know why. The meat is deep, dark red, the fat is pure white, and and the flavor is unbeatable. They are all pasture-raised and never fed corn or soy. We love these pigs! We love their meat. And we're so thankful to be partnering with our friends in Grass Valley.

The term "grass-fed beef" can often be misleading to the consumer. It is easy for ranches to promote their product as grass-fed beef. However, more times than not, they are fed grain in the last 30 to 60 days before butchering to fatten them up. What grain does to beef is actually quite sad. The minute you introduce grain into their system, the Omega 3's dissipate. 


