


Here in El Dorado Hills, we love the community and neighbors. Apart from family time we socialize with friends in the neighborhood whom we call the "EDH Family."







CHEF KEVIN DECOMINATE REPORTED BY




Teagan hopes to continue playing basketball at a college that fits her athletic and academic goals. She has already received

The most amazing sunrise on Oahu is at Lanikai Beach where you can see the sun rise over the Mokes, which are





UMPKIN CHEESECAKE BARS...

The PERFECT Holiday Treat!

- 7 tablespoons melted unsalted butter
- 10 crushed graham crackers
- 32 oz room temperature cream cheese
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 1/4 cups granulated sugar
- 115 oz can of pumpkin puree
- 1 teaspoon Pumpkin pie spice




Use 1 tablespoon of the melted butter to grease a pan. Add the rest of the butter and graham crackers to a bowl and stir until the mixture has a wet sand texture. Evenly cover the bottom of a greased baking dish with the graham cracker mixture and place into the refrigerator. Next, combine the cream cheese, vanilla, eggs and sugar in a large bowl until the mixture is smooth. Spread half of the cheesecake batter on top of the chilled crust and freeze. Preheat the oven to 325 °F (160 °C). Add the pumpkin puree and pumpkin pie spice to the remaining cheesecake batter and mix until it is incorporated. Spread the pumpkin cheesecake mixture over frozen cheesecake mixture and bake for 30 minutes. Allow the cheesecake to cool at room temperature. Optionally, refrigerate it overnight to allow the flavors to meld together. Once it is completely cooled, slice and serve. Enjoy with loved ones!

This recipe is one of my favorites as it fuses two of the best deserts together...pumpkin pie and cheesecake! I love to bake this to give to my friends and family around the holiday season! Feel free to play around with a little and make it your own. Happy Holidays!

Apple sometimes gets a bad rap for developing a closed ecosystem, meaning it all works well together if you choose only Apple products, but often not so much if you stray from the Apple brand and use, say, a Windows PC for your personal computing tasks (as I do). There is an easy option to be able to view an up-to-date version of your iPhone calendar (and a whole lot more) from a Windows PC.

The easiest way to see your latest iPhone information is to use Apple's **iCloud Web** app.

- 1: Enter "icloud.com" into your web browser (Edge, Chrome, etc.). **See Figure 1 Sign in.**
- 2: Enter your Apple ID account email and password, and you'll be presented with a screen like this (with *your* name and picture): **See figure 2 Main Menu**
- 3: From this menu, you have access to a wide variety of the information stored in your iPhone (or more accurately, stored in Apple's "cloud").
- 4: Select "Calendar" from the menu, and a nicely formatted up-todate calendar page will appear. Here's mine for January 7th: See figure 3 - Calendar page.

From this page you can add, edit and update nearly anything in your iPhone calendar. Hitting the back arrow will take you back to the menu with your face on it, where you can access Contacts, Photos, Notes, Etc., and even find your iPhone on a map!
