#### "Love at first sight...Pretty much"

Jen and Allan Priest met at a college birthday party at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo in 1989 and, although it would take a few months before an official first date, "the sparks" were immediate. Actually, Jen was set up with his roommate at the party (Mark Denholm, now a fellow EDH resident) and thankfully for Allan, there was no interest there and as she later noted, "She chased him until he caught her."

Married in 1992, their careers took them to Sacramento - gladly away from the crowding and traffic of the Bay Area and Southern California. In 1996 they were looking for just the right home in the Sacramento area and had their sights on an existing house in Elk Grove. Fortunately, one weekend they took a drive east to check out the fast-growing area of El Dorado Hills and on a whim, stopped into a real estate office on Green Valley Road and grabbed a free map of local lots and homes for sale. After falling in love with this little community, they dropped their offer

in Elk Grove and bought a vacant lot in Governor's Village West. "Learning-by-doing" along the way, the couple then designed and built their "dream home" in 1999 – moving into a great neighborhood and community to raise their kids.

#### **Deep California Roots**

A fifth-generation Californian with gold rush era family history, Allan was born and raised in Morgan Hill, CA - right down the street from orchards and crop fields his family had owned and worked for decades. In 1990, he received a BS degree in natural resource management and moved to Sacramento to begin a 20-year career as an environmental consultant. After building a small engineering and environmental consulting firm from 45 to over 400 employees, in 2009, he and his business partners sold their business to HDR Engineering. A year later, he left the industry and started a second career as a real estate broker, investor and builder. Aside from managing a number of residential rentals they own throughout El

Dorado County, he co-owns ESI Builders & Remodelers in EDH – working with his partner Dave Sipes to help homeowners experience their own dreams with major remodels or new custom homes.

#### **Valley Girl**

Jen grew up in Chatsworth, CA (yep - a "Valley Girl"), where she lived with her mom, Wilma, a widow with a unique zest for life. She received a BS degree in recreation from Cal Poly and moved to Sacramento to begin her career as a recreation therapist in local rehabilitation hospitals and skilled nursing facilities. After 11 years of shuffling between daycares and work in Rancho Cordova, she paused her career and took on the many challenges of busy daily schedules...schools, sports practices and EDH life. With Allan traveling nearly every week for work, the job was often an ominous one - but it gave her and the family an opportunity to create and enjoy a great network of families and friends in El Dorado Hills. In late 2018, Jen purchased an "Assisted Living Locators" franchise and is now busy building her business as a Senior Advisor. Jen uses her passion for elder care and community service to assist local seniors and their families navigate the complex processes and identify the best senior care and living options for their loved ones.









#### **Kids Sports Life**

Blessed with two great kids, Justin (age 23) and Megan (age 21), the past 20 years in El Dorado Hills has been more than full of activities, sports and friendships. There was seldom a season off as baseball, soccer, volleyball, basketball, track, football, swimming and other non-team sports took center stage for the family. Many friends and relationships were built and strengthened as they traveled across California and the nation playing and watching competitive sports with other local families. Few games or matches were ever missed – time Jen and Allan wouldn't trade for all the gold in the Mother Lode.

Also, besides the clear lessons on how to be effective teammates and leaders, and how to best juggle and manage priorities – both Megan and Justin built "never give up" work ethics. This foundation carried them both to great athletic successes at Oak Ridge High School and later in NCAA Division I sports (Justin: Football; Megan: Volleyball). With very proud parents supporting them, both kids also achieved academic honors at the University of San Diego and look forward to their future careers (hopefully in Northern California!).

#### **EDH Community Involvement.**

Finally, one of the most important treasures the family has found in EDH is the involvement of local community members in making EDH a great place to live and play. Inspired by many fellow residents with a similar focus, both Jen and Allan are involved in the local community – including building awareness and addressing the needs of our local citizens, schools and philanthropic organizations. 












Step through the doors of Back Bistro, look around and enjoy all the things we love about California. You can't miss the wine wall above the main bar and the modern sleek appeal of the décor. It's more than just a wine bar. It's the only local restaurant located in the Palladio. Local meaning there's no corporate structure here, just great food from the farm to your plate.

Back Bistro is owned and operated by Jeff and Gail Back. The couple started the restaurant in a small building in a Folsom neighborhood back in 2008. Last year they got an opportunity they couldn't refuse to move and expand the restaurant to the Palladio.






















"We're trying to get away from the wine bar mentality," says owner Jeff Back. Being the only local place to eat in the Palladio, Back wants you to come in and be blown away by the food and service.

Everything is fresh. The only thing you'll see freezers for here is for ice. Back sources most of his foods locally. Some things are flown in fresh, like the scallops – they're straight from Maine.

"This is upscale California. We're not trying to go fine dining, but we also don't want to be a grab and go spot," Back said.

The menu offers something for everyone. Steak and potatoes are a popular choice. You also can't go wrong with the ahi poke wontons with sweet onions. If you're not looking to fill up on a big meal, the charcuterie boards are a great idea. The boards are filled to the brim with cured meats, dried fruits, olives and a baguette.

Of course, you'll need some wine or a beverage to wash down all of that food. "We just got the Wine Spectator award. We have been recognized for our old vintage list," says Back. As a sommelier at the bistro, Back loves to challenge guests to try something new. "We have local, Napa and wines from all over the world...some labels you won't recognize."

# Cheetah Experience...

NICOLE'S CAPTIVATING TALES!







I knew that while I was in Cape Town
I wanted to do one of the most touristy
things possible...interact with a big cat.
However, I was concerned about how to
do this ethically. I'd heard horror stories

of animals that are drugged, or eventually released into enclosed hunting grounds...and as an animal lover, I would never support this kind of practice. Through my own research, I discovered that Cheetah Outreach offers visitors the opportunity to both interact with a cheetah and promote their survival in the wild. After my visit there, I knew I wanted to return as a volunteer, so I applied immediately and was quickly accepted.


Generally, a farmer will lose 30-40% of their livestock annually to wild animals...a huge financial burden to those farmers. That is essentially a 30-40% decrease in the money they could be making that year. However, when an Anatolian Shepherd Dog is paired with a herd of livestock, loss is reduced to less than five percent. During my time volunteering there, I learned about how Cheetah Outreach pairs up with farmers, giving them an Anatolian Shepherd that they have bred, with food and medical expenses covered for an entire year. In exchange, the farmer must sign a contract promising not to intentionally kill any wild animals. After the year is up, the farmers can keep the dog, in turn extending the contract













indefinitely. Through the dog program, Cheetah Outreach has converted 1,640 square miles of land that was previously unsafe for cheetahs to roam on

into land that is now safe.









Volunteering at Cheetah Outreach provided me a behind-the-scenes look at the work that the volunteers and staff put in daily to protect the cheetah population. I worked alongside the backhandlers and saw how strong the relationships they built with the animals were. Many of the cheetahs could even recognize the voices of the backhandlers and some of the older volunteers, and they would purr when those individuals were with them.







Other than losing my phone to the ocean, I have no complaints about my time in South Africa. I am fortunate to have traveled extensively for somebody my age, and Cape Town is by far my favorite place I have been. Despite the ocean water being the coldest I have ever felt, I still found myself at home at the various beaches. As much as possible, my roommates and I would pack bags with blankets, wine and food from Sushi Box (our favorite restaurant in Cape Town), and head down to the beaches (or mountains overlooking the beach) for evening sunset outings. These are among some of my favorite memories in Cape Town and I am already looking forward to going back.









Beardie, So Nice to Meet You!











## AN "UNSTOPPABLE FORCE" ON THE COURT!









You probably recall a big story around the 2016 election, the huge release of emails from the Democratic National Committee (DNC) consisting of email from Hillary Clinton, her staff and others. One person, John Podesta, was blamed for it as the one who opened a tainted email that allowed Russian cybercriminals to access his email system, and who then posted those emails for all to see on WikiLeaks, possibly contributing to Clinton's loss of the election.

I'm not political, so I don't have a political story to share, but rather a cautionary tale about email security. Here's what really happened at the DNC that day: Researchers from the Atlanta-based cybersecurity firm Dell SecureWorks reported that the emails had been obtained through a data theft carried out by the hacker group Fancy Bear, a group of Russian intelligence-linked hackers that were also responsible for cyberattacks that targeted the DNC and Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee (DCCC), resulting in WikiLeaks publishing emails from those hacks.

SecureWorks determined that Fancy Bear had sent Podesta an email on March 19, 2016, that had the appearance of a Google security alert, but actually contained a misleading link—a strategy widely known as spear-phishing.


You might recall that the term "phishing" is used when many tainted emails, possibly in the thousands or millions, are sent out broadly, even globally, in hopes that a large number of people will open the email, and follow the email directions, exposing their bank accounts or other items of value to the attacker or attackers. In a "spear-phishing" attack, the attacker is looking for a specific person or persons to fall for the email, to allow the attacker to access something specific to that person's situation, such as their employer, financial, or computer files. The tactic has also been used by hackers to break into the accounts of other notable persons, such as Colin Powell.

In the tainted email, a link—which used the URL shortening service
Bitly—brought Podesta to a fake login page where he entered his Gmail credentials. To his credit, prior to clicking on the tainted link, Podesta forwarded the email to the IT department of the DNC, as he suspected it of being a fake, but it was described as "legitimate" in an e-mail sent by a department employee, who later said he meant to write "illegitimate."

SecureWorks had tracked the activities of Fancy Bear for more than a year before the cyberattack and in June 2016 had reported the group made use of malicious Bitly links and fake Google login pages to trick targets into divulging their passwords.

However, the hackers left some of their Bitly accounts public, allowing SecureWorks to trace many of their links to email accounts targeted with spear-phishing attacks. Of this list of targeted accounts, more than 100 were policy advisors to Clinton or members of her presidential campaign, and by June, 20 staff members had clicked on the phishing links.


How to protect yourself from this sort of attack if you suspect an email is bogus: First, always verify the actual email address the email originates from, then if appropriate, show the email to someone you trust. Look to see that the email includes real information you recognize like your account number, a specific balance due, or when your account was originated. Look at the link that you're being asked to click, and verify the Internet web site address is actually going where you would expect it to. If the address appears scrambled or is going to a site you don't recognize, don't click on it, but rather call the phone number of the sender to verify they sent it. If you're unable to contact the sender, save the email, and see if you get another one - if it's important, you likely will; if it's a phishing attack, you probably won't.






Today, Crack'd toffee is an artisanal, micro-batch confection still made by friends and family who gather together around the kitchen to make something truly exceptional. The size of our kitchen may have grown but the spirit of companionship at the heart of our story hasn't changed.

Based in El Dorado Hills, Crack'd Toffee is an artisanal small-batch treat which comes in original/semi-sweet, white chocolate, dark chocolate, vegan dark chocolate and 'premium" dark infused with Hawaiian coffee and toasted cacao nibs. The company's toffees recently earned Gold and Silver awards at the International Chocolate Salon's Top Toffee Awards held earlier this spring.

#### **Toffee Cookies**

• 1/2 pound salted butter (room temp)

- · 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1 and 1/2 cups light brown sugar
- 1 and 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
- · 3 eggs (room temp will make the cookie dough fluffier)
- 3 cups flour
- 1 and 1/2 half teaspoons baking soda
- 1 and 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 1 and 1/2 cups of small toffee pieces (any flavor)
- 1 cup chocolate chips (any flavor)

(Note: I like to mix the flavors; White Toffee and dark chips or Coffee Toffee and white chips.)

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Sift dry ingredients together. In a stand mixer or with a handheld mixer combine the sugars, butter and vanilla. When that is combined and fluffy, add the slightly beaten eggs. Slowly (1/2 cup or so at a time) add in the dry ingredients. Add the toffee pieces and chocolate chips stir to combine. If you use small scoops, bake for 8-9 minutes, large scoops bake 15-20.

Do not crowd them, and use parchment paper to make clean up easier. Warm or cool, they are delicious. Use them to make ice cream sandwiches too!






