

THL: Thanks Joe and Antoinette for pinch hitting for us in the bottom of the ninth! (Joe and Antoinette were originally scheduled for November, but our October family cancelled a few days before deadline!) We truly appreciate you coming through for us at the last minute and sharing your story. Antoinette, tell us about how you and Joe met.

Antoinette: We met in the 60's in San Francisco at Jolly Friars nightclub. Joe was scheduled for back surgery the next week and could barely walk straight, but we were both out for a night of dancing. Someone stole his brand new suede jacket with his car keys in the pocket. When we went out to his car, it had been hit by another car and was dented on the fender. I took him home to get his keys and then back to the nightclub to get his car. Everything went wrong except one thing...meeting each other!

THL: Joe, how did you get started in your announcing career back in 1977?

Joe: I wasn't good enough to play...Haha! That was the best thing that ever happened to me. I would have worked 5 years as opposed to 42 years. I took 2 yrs of broadcast journalism, then started working.

THL: Joe, you just retired in February of this year, after 42 years of play by play announcing for major league baseball, nineteen of which was spent as 'The Voice of the Orioles', is that right? What is your fondest memory

from those years? What was the most exciting play of your announcing career?


Joe: Yes, that's correct. My fondest memory was my very first broadcast on KSFR radio, the flagship station for SF giants. I flew to Atlanta. SF Giants were playing the Atlanta Braves. Al Michaels was my first broadcast partner, and that was really special. I got to announce a few games with him before he went to work for ABC, nationally. And, I landed the job with the SF Giants! I would have to say that announcing for couple of World Series game 7's were definitely my most exciting career memories...the Florida Marlins & SF Giants. Another memorable, historical and hilarious memory was the Minnesota Twins vs the Oakland A's. It was at the Metrodome, and as you may or may not know, it has a false roof with ventilation holes that provide pressure to keep the roof up. Dave Kingman, who was known for his pop ups, popped one sky high. The players were covering heads with their mitts, so it wouldn't hit them when it came down. And, here's the hilarious part...it stuck in one of those ventilation holes and never came down! That had never happened before and has never happened since. The Umps had to get together to figure out what to make of the play. In the end, they gave Dave a double! (Laughs) The Metrodome and the media made a big deal of it all and promoted, 'What goes up, must come down.' So, the very next game, they sent a kid way up there to get the ball down. Mickey hatcher volunteered to catch it. The weird thing is that when a ball is up that high and comes down, there is no spin on it. It actually turns into knuckle ball, bobbing & weaving. Mickey was trying as hard as he could to get a beat on the ball so he could catch it. Long story short, he missed the ball, it landed on his toe, and he was jumping around the field in pain. You'll have to YouTube it!

THL: Antoinette, you & Joe have 3 grown children, is that correct? Where were you living when they were young and how did you manage raising three kids, one of whom was on a popular sitcom: Saved by the Bell...The New Class, and Joes travel schedule for so many years?

Antoinette: We lived in Belmont, then Rancho Marietta when the kids were in grammar school, junior high & high school. Rancho Marietta was a wonderful place to raise kids. It was a strong community. It was beautiful as well, with 2 lakes very close by. They had rope swings and were a great hang out spot. The kids loved to swim and play there all summer long. They had fireworks on the 4th of July. It was a lot like El Dorado Hills in that way. Joe was basically gone from February to October, unless the Orioles went to the playoffs. Then it was even longer. I barely survived! Haha!

THL: Joe, what are your children up to now? How many grandchildren do you have?

Joe: Natalie is our daughter. She is married and lives in Castle Pines, Colorado. They have a daughter named Carson who just turned 5. Tony is a National Sales manager and lives in Burbank. He and his wife have 2 boys. Jacob is 12 and is a cancer survivor. He had what they call a Wilms Tumor. We were very lucky. He lost a kidney, but is fine now. Thank God! His younger brother, Thomas











is 10. Jonathan, our son who was on Saved By the Bell: The New Class, is still in the entertainment industry. He lives in N. Hollywood, and makes documentaries, along with other film projects.

THL: Antoinette, when did you move to El Dorado Hills, and what are some of the things you love most about this wonderful community?

Antoinette: We moved here in 2011. We came from living in Florida for 19 yrs. We were aware of Serrano when we lived in Rancho Marietta, and we knew it was the kind of community we would be looking for later. THL: Antoinette, what are some of your hobbies?



- · BBQ Sauce (I use Sweet Baby Rays Hickory and Brown Sugar)


Recipe:

Bring smoker to 125-150 degrees, place meat bone side down on the grill. Smoke for 2 hours. Increase heat to 225 degrees and cook for 2 more hours. Baste ribs with BBQ Sauce and wrap with tin foil, cook for 90 more minutes. Take tin foil off and finish cooking, approximately 30 more minutes, until ribs are at desired tenderness.



















If you have an Apple Mac, you can ignore this month's story, but if you have a PC, and it's running Windows XP or Windows 7, read on. It's time to update your PC software, and Microsoft is trying to make it easier, and less expensive, than ever.

You should always use the latest version of Windows, the operating system software that manages how your PC hardware runs programs, communicates on the Internet and protects you from attacks by cybercriminals. Yes, Windows does protect you, but only most effectively if you are using the latest version, with the more sophisticated updates and fixes that address past vulnerabilities in the software itself, as well as issues found recently in the microprocessor (CPU) hardware in your PC. Cybercriminals are consistently getting more sophisticated in the ways that they use to steal your credentials, data and possibly money, and I've written about this in many issues past.

If your PC is more than 5 years old, the best way to upgrade is to buy a new modern PC with good specifications...choosing correctly will ensure you have another good five-plus years of performance, and in many cases, the company that sells you the new PC can help move your data to the new one...ask them before you buy.

Updating your existing PC to Windows 10 can be a hassle, so err on the side of protecting your data. Reach out to a trusted PC professional or a service that will confidently upgrade your software without losing any of your purchased applications or your data.

If you do feel you can do it, here are the basic steps involved...
 space does not allow me to go into detail, so be sure to do your

research to ensure your success based on your specific situation.

- Windows 10 is available by buying a new device or a full version of the software, which is usually \$199 for Windows 10 Pro and \$139 for Windows 10 Home. See if you have the right to upgrade for free. If you bought Windows 7 or later from a store, you'll have a label on the Windows 7 box with a "product key," which is a long string of letters that look like this: xxxxx-xxxxx-xxxxx-xxxxx-xxxxx. It's five sets of five letters and numbers. For advanced users, although the Microsoft free upgrade period is over, users report that they have successfully upgraded to Windows 10 for free using a key from a storebought copy of Windows 7.
- Back up your computer, just in case something goes wrong. I usually back up all my files and data to a portable USB SSD hard drive. At a minimum, back up all the files in the C:\ user directories, which is usually where the personal files, photos, music, videos, etc. for each user are stored.
- Make sure you have copies of all the paid application software you rely on, like Microsoft Office, Photoshop, etc. You will need to reinstall it, but won't want to have to go re-buy that software after you complete the update.
- Read the information at https://support.microsoft.com/en-us/help/12435/windows-10-upgrade-faq to get the answers to many questions we don't have space here to answer.

The bottom line is this: It might be a pain to upgrade your PC to the latest version of Windows, but it is important if you use your PC for financial purposes like online banking, stock trading, managing your household finances or if you keep a lot of personal data on it that would be costly or inconvenient if it were stolen or published by a criminal.
