
As the day turned to evening, the party continued late into the night under the stars. All in all it was a night to be remembered.



travel mania

My travel experience is a little different than that of the average 20-year-old college student. I have represented the USA in Israel twice in two different sports (soccer and track), have played basketball in a diplomacy project with kids my age from several Balkan countries, built a school with and for Costa Rican locals, and personally witnessed the smallest nation, Iceland, to ever qualify for the soccer European Championship. While I've appreciated all of these experiences, what I'll remember most are the times when things haven't gone as planned.

My first time representing the USA in Israel was back in 2013, where I was the second youngest player on the junior girls' soccer team. It was great bonding with Israeli soccer players and earning a gold medal for team USA. On the night of the opening ceremony, among thousands of people from different countries, my teammate Sarina and I got separated from our team (and naturally both of our phones were dead). Essentially, the two of us, just fifteen years of age at the time, spent hours in a foreign country separated from our team amidst the chaos and excitement of an Olympic affiliate event. We learned very quickly how to communicate with non-English speakers and how to navigate our way around Israel.


















Another instance that I know caused my mom some stress was during a layover in Texas during my trip to Costa Rica. Due to flight changes, I ended up becoming stranded in a Texas airport overnight with a couple other teens from the trip. If you have seen the movie "Unaccompanied Minors," you can imagine how our night went. We got some snacks with our food vouchers from the airline; played some ukulele in hopes of receiving tips from fellow travelers (we didn't have many fans - maybe it would have helped if I knew how to play the ukulele); played soccer with some younger kids we made friends with - which resulted in the soccer ball jamming one of the moving walkways (oops!); and

slept only a little. By the time we finally landed in Costa Rica, we were exhausted, but in good spirits, and we were still excited for what the rest of the trip had to offer.

So, from the Eiffel Tower to the Great Wall of China, to the Jordanian Desert, and to Eastern Africa, my fondest memories are the interactions I've had with the many diverse people I've met in all these places. Traveling offers a unique opportunity to speak with and learn from others who have different experiences and perspectives. I am so thankful for opportunities I have had to travel, and can only hope to be fortunate enough to make this a lifelong journey.



This is a continuation of last month's topic, specifically ways to dip your toes into making your home "smart." Today, I'll talk about three options that don't cost a lot but will introduce you to use forms of the smart home concept.

One important note, if you feel that you'll want to dive in and do a full smart home project, where most or all of the items in your house are controlled, you're far better off using a single product that is designed to control many things (lights, thermostats, whole house audio, garage doors, motorized shades, security, pool pumps, fountains, cameras and more) than buying several different "smart" products that each have a different smartphone app to control it. The latter quickly becomes limiting and confusing, especially if you don't have access to your phone or tablet. If you choose a comprehensive solution (Control4, Savant and Crestron are the leaders) you'll want a professional to plan, install and maintain the system.

The system I'm most familiar with because it's in my home is Control4 (www.control4.com). It's designed to make your home simple and convenient by putting everything in well-organized menus, on wall mounted touch screens around the home, as well as identical displays on your smartphone, tablet, PC or Mac, so you can monitor and control the home from anywhere in the world. It is professionally installed, not a hobbyist sort of system, and has been reliable for me and friends for years. It can be as simple and inexpensive, or as comprehensive and moderately expensive as you like.

If you want to try a few introductory "point solutions," here are a few inexpensive starter ideas:

Lights – there are several options that can enable you to have a few lights around your house that can be controlled from an app and can change color to achieve various scenes or effects in your room. Phillips, Lutron and Leviton are well-established companies and I recommend you look at their offers first. Avoid names you've never heard of, as they might only be in the market for a short time, limiting your long-term satisfaction and ability to add lights in the future. Home Depot and Lowe's stock these.

Heating and A/C - You've likely heard of Nest, now owned by Google. Nest thermostats cost about \$250, easily replace your existing one and are Internet connected so you can change the desired temp in your home from your smartphone, even while away. It's a great feature if you go on vacation and realize you left the heat on - you can fix that with your smartphone anywhere in the world and avoid a surprise heating bill. The Nest also has a sensor to determine if you're home and will turn down the heat if it thinks you're away, saving money.

Music & voice control - the hands-down favorite device in our home today is the Amazon Alexa "smart speaker" (also Google Home is a good option). In our home, Alexa plays music, answers questions and is connected to Control4, and can control virtually everything in our house. Romeo and I have an occasional party, and it's nice to say "Alexa, turn on party time" and see our lighting set perfectly, music come on at the right levels, and heat set right for a crowd.

Blue Quinoa Salad with Thai Peanut & Tamarind Sauce

Blue Quinoa:

- · 1 cup organic quinoa
- 1 cup butterfly pea tea extracts (or you can use any of red cabbage, beets, or carrots juice for the color)
- · Cook quinoa per instructions and set aside to chill for the salad

Thai Peanut & Tamarind Sauce:

- 500 ml coconut milk or a can of 13.5 oz
- * 2 ounce (1/4 cup) of Massamun Curry Paste (mild & flavorful) or red curry paste is fine, too
- 1 tablespoon roasted chili paste (mild flavor)
- 1/2 tablespoon salt
- 3/4 cup any peanut butter (crunchy or smooth); I use Skippy
- 3/4 cup condensed milk
- 1 tablespoon palm sugar
- 2 tablespoon Tamarind Sauce (or distilled vinegar if you can't find Tamarind Sauce)

Combine all ingredients and mix well, boil on medium to low heat, stir closely until the coconut breaks out its oil. About 10-15 min. If the sauce is too thick you can add 1/4 cup water and keep stirring until you get a smooth texture.




