

Do you have any family traditions? My kids are 11 months and three weeks apart so for six days of the year, they are the same age. We

call it "twin week" and celebrate by going to the Purple Place for a sundae and a couple other fun things. We celebrate half birthdays and full birthdays with one-on-one time after school, bowling and going out to eat. Basically, we are always looking for a reason to have more fun!



The Samsung Frame TV above the fireplace has the ability to display thousands of high-quality digital art pieces that can evolve with their personal tastes or the seasons.







We flew into Fort Lauderdale on Friday, February 12, rented a car at the airport and drove down to Key Largo. I immediately tried calling them but there was no answer. That was a harrowing drive...two hours down to Key Largo, not knowing if we'd have a place to sleep once we got there! Key Largo is pretty "provincial"...it's not like you can just easily find another place to stay at a late hour.

There was a pretty crowded restaurant next door called Snappers, so I suggested Russ go in there to ask if they had any idea what the hotel next door did about late check-ins.

One of the restaurant workers overheard him and was kind enough to walk him over there, help him find the lobby (upstairs on the second floor), and then they were able to find a mailbox of sorts outside the lobby that had an envelope in it with our room key in it and our name on the front of the envelope. WHEW!

The next day was Saturday, and we drove down to the Theater of the Sea, which is a marine mammal park with dolphin shows, sea lion shows, bird shows and other rescued marine animals. The dolphin show was one of the best I've seen--absolutely captivating! I decided I wanted to do a little extra thing and bought a "sea lion encounter," where I got to interact with one of the sea lions. Her name was Monica, and I completely fell in love with her! She was a showgirl after my own heart, and was born for the stage. She looked

so proud after every trick she did, and would even smile on demand for the camera!

That evening we went to Mile Marker 88 for dinner, which is truly a special place--an outdoor bar and fine dining restaurant right on the sand. We had drinks and dinner and waded out into the water and watched the sunset there. It was magical.

The next day was Valentine's Day so we went back to the hotel to get a good night's sleep because we were all set to scuba dive off of Key Largo for Valentine's Day. We were so excited! And then when we showed up to check in, they couldn't find our reservation. Even though I had booked it a month earlier for February 14, somehow our reservation got entered for March 14. Ugh! We were so disappointed and spent the next few hours looking for another dive option. We eventually found one for the following morning, with an early morning launch before we headed down to Key West.

We ended up having our Valentine's Day dinner at Snappers, on the patio over the water, right next to our hotel. Then we went to bed to prepare for our early morning dive...and ended up getting woken up even earlier than expected when the smoke detector in our room started chirping at around 3 AM! No staff comes in until 7 AM, so we were stuck listening to that thing chirp every 30 seconds for about four hours in the second half of the night. Needless to say, we will not be staying there again.

After the few snafus at the first part of our trip, everything after that went well, thankfully! We had a great two-tank boat dive off



of Key Largo that Monday morning the 15th, and it felt so great to dive together! Visibility was OK but seas were rough, and one of us got a little sick. I'll let you guess which one. Haha!

After our dive, we started the drive down the Overseas Highway all the way down to Key West. It was beautiful! Such crystal









clear blue and turquoise water all around. We stopped and had lunch at Robbie's in Islamorada, where you can feed giant tarpon, and we got super lucky and got to see a few manatees there as well, trying to take the food away from the tarpon. We ate lunch on the sand, overlooking the fish cleaning station where the people come back from their fishing tours and clean the fish. They throw the guts down into the water where the pelicans fight over it, and when we were there, there were also a few sharks fighting the pelicans for the fish guts! It was crazy watching them thrash around and come up out of the water to get a mouthful of fish guts!

We got into Key West on Monday night, checked into our hotel and walked to Duval Street, which is like Bourbon Street in New Orleans. Tons of restaurants and bars and shops, and tons of tourists. It was fun people-watching.

The next day we explored the island more and also did another two-tank boat dive. This time the water was not as rough, but the visibility was not as good, either. We stayed very close to our guide, and at one point we found ourselves about 12 feet away from two giant nurse sharks just lying







on the bottom! That was such a thrill for me--I have probably been on around 100 scuba dives in my life and had never seen a shark before that point. Nurse sharks are harmless bottom feeders so there was no reason to be scared--just excited!

Wednesday was our last full day there, and we made the most of it. In the morning we went on a guided jet ski tour all around the island. Our guide was great! And I felt like the hero in an action movie driving my jet ski at high speeds. We stopped at a sandbar and our guide took a picture of us with our jet skis. After that we rented a golf cart and drove around the island for the afternoon on that...it's the perfect way to get around there! We stopped at the






Butterfly Conservatory, where one of the butterflies landed on Russ three times--on his hand, on his cheek and then on his heart. It was a magical experience. We also toured Ernest Hemingway's house that day. And we found our favorite bar on the island...the Southernmost Point Bar. They have a little replica of the landmark at the actual Southernmost Point of the US, and we got the table right next to it, so I got to meet and talk to a lot of people as they all came up and wanted to take their picture with it.

We drove back up the Overseas Highway on Thursday and stayed the night in Fort Lauderdale near the airport for our early morning flight back home on Friday. We made a happy hour stop in Miami's South Beach, where I spent a good part of my early 20s, just for old time's sake.

What a great trip, and VERY MUCH NEEDED after the tough year we all had.
